Enduring Faith: Wang Mingdao and the Emergence of the House Church Movement in China

Wang Mingdao is considered a founding father of the Chinese house church movement. Wang successfully established the Christian Tabernacle with no external influence, refusing to compromise theological principles. He resolutely withstood attempts to undermine his faith, inleuding efforts to persuade him to join government-sanctioned Christian churches from both the Japenese during their occupation of northern China and the Chinese government. Subsequently, Wang was imprisoned by the Chinese Communist government for more than 20 years.

Pastor Thomas Wang

Pastor Wang, the founder of the evangelical organization, Great Commission Center International, attended Wang Mingdao's Christian Tabernacle church.

Pastor Liu Tongsu

Pastor Liu is the senior pastor at Mountain View Chinese Christian Church in San Jose, California, and a former researcher at the Chinese Academy of Social Sciences.

Floyd Brobbel

Brobbel, Vice President of International Ministry and Operations at Voice of the Martyrs Canada (VOMC), is responsible for developing partnerships and projects to assist the persecuted.

Dr. Duke is the Vice President for Public Policy and Research of the Ethics & Religious Liberty Commission at the Southern Baptist Convention.
